I. Call to Order- Councilman St. John opened the Village of Sunbury Services Committee virtual meeting at 6:30 pm Wednesday, March 3, 2021

V. Open Issues

Parkinson

Gave an update on various projects.

Little Walnut Creek Sewer – Bids were opened and the apparent low bidder Helms and Sons Excavating Inc., 1753 Lima Ave, Findlay, OH with a bid of \$2,248,040.50. There will be a purchase order during Council for \$40,000.00 for tree clearing. This will be because the loan funding will come after the deadline for the removal of the bat habitat. If the Village pays for the removal of the trees, the bid price will be reduced. If the **contractor** finishes the job after the funding it will be included in the loan amount and the bid price will not be altered.

Wastewater Treatment Plant improvement – currently scheduled to start late 21 or 22

OPWC Street – program

The Village did not win funding from OPWC. The current plan is to take the local funding and apply it to a pared down street project. Parkinson will develop a colorized map for presentation to Council of various options and expense.

Right Turn Lane – West Cherry Street

bids were opened, Columbus Asphalt Paving, Inc. was the apparent low bidder at \$538,853.65.
